Overview of Littlestown Fish and Game Association

The Association was founded in 1937. On May 3, 1941 application for incorporation (Charter) was made with the State of Pennsylvania. On April 11, 1941, the application for incorporation was continued and on July 10, 1941 the Association came into existence. On March 2, 1948 the first parcel of land of the present location was purchased from Annie E. Swope, Widow, Silver Run, Carroll County, Maryland. On May 15, 1974 a second parcel of land was purchased from Karl P. Bankert and Helen M. Bankert, husband and wife, of Germany Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania. Recently a section was entered into the Adams County Land Conservancy.

Getting Started as a new member of Littlestown Fish and Game

This Association was formed for the protection and preservation of wildlife, perpetuate hunting and fishing, perpetuate the skill of angling, archery and all gunning sports. It was formed to educate and provide the sportsman a safe and secure area to practice. To encourage a spirit of sportsmanship and fair play, to aid in the enforcement of the laws of this Commonwealth governing conservation.

Your Membership

- Membership runs from January to December and is renewable each year beginning October 1st.
- New members and renewing members can join by visiting our website or attending a general membership meeting

Using LFG Facilities

- Read Rules and for the general rules, safety, and times governing use of the various amenities of the club.
- **Wear Membership Badge at all times while on the LFG property**
- Close and lock main gate when you are the last person to leave LFG property
- When in the clubhouse, all firearms must be unloaded, action open and preferably cased whenever possible.

Meetings

- Our Regularly scheduled membership meeting is held the second Wednesday of every month in the Main Hall of the clubhouse starting at 7PM.
- The general format of meetings are:
 - Committee reports
 - Old Business – discussions
 - New Business - discussions
- When you arrive for a meeting
 - **Have your membership card, must Be Displayed at Meetings too.**
 - Sign in
 - Pick up any handouts
 - There is open seating for meetings – sit anywhere
 - There is a soda machine in the back of the main hall by the kitchen

Kitchen

The kitchen is open for most public events, only kitchen committee members should be in the kitchen. A current list of menu items is on the website.

Firearms in the Clubhouse

Guns are permitted in clubhouse, but -

- Do not lay your firearm on the tables, use the racks.
- Conceal carry permit holders may carry anytime, remember to keep firearm concealed. **Exception: During a firearms training session, NO LIVE AMMO is allowed in the clubhouse.**

Hunting on Property

Safety committee handles the hunting program on the property. To hunt you must register with the safety committee, sign a liability release; post your card in designated area at the clubhouse - Archery only for deer, shotgun only for small game. Specific rules are outlined for hunting and for reference on the website or thru the Hunting committee.

Fishing

Fishing is catch and release only. Proper care should be paid to your proximity to the Rifle range to ensure safety.

Map is representative and not to scale. Range limiting zones and identified areas are for reference only. Always refer to the specific rules and regulations when participating in any shooting sport or visiting the property.
